



ROTARY 5K RUN FOR POLIO & Quarter Mile Kids Run

Saturday 9 April 2011 • Winchester, VA • 5K at 9 AM • Kids run at 10 AM

COURSES The 5K (3.1 mi.) race follows an out-and-back route on rolling, paved roads through Jim Barnett Park and the campus of Shenandoah University, with a mid-course loop through a nearby neighborhood. The quarter mile kids run uses a flat out-and-back route.

NOTE: This year's 5K race will start approximately a quarter mile from the finish line at the Rotary Shelter. Please allow yourself enough time to walk there in time for the 9 AM start.

AWARDS 5K awards will be given to the top three males & females in the following divisions: Overall, Masters, 9 & under, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, and 70 & over. All children in the kids run will receive medals.

REGISTRATION The 5K is **\$16** for Shenandoah Valley Runners members and **\$17** for non-members, either early or on race day. T-shirts will be available for the first 100 5K registrants. The kids run is **\$11** with a t-shirt or **\$4** without a shirt. Make checks payable to "Winchester Rotary Club" and send checks & entry forms to Rotary 5K Run for Polio, c/o Chris Northrup, Northrup Consulting, 294 Huntersridge Rd., Winchester, VA 22602-6801. Race day registration begins at 8:00 AM.

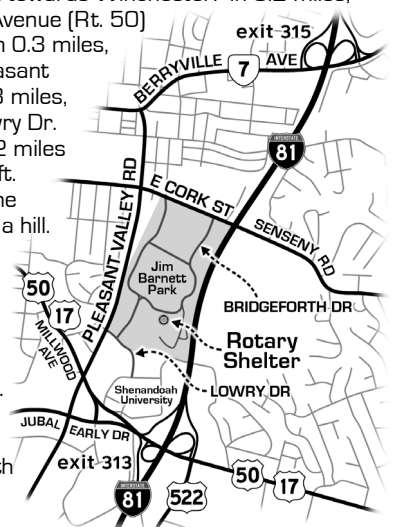

LOCATION The Rotary Shelter, on the southern side of Winchester's Jim Barnett Park.

Directions from the south: Take I-81 north to exit 313 (Routes 50/17/522) and head north/west towards Winchester. In 0.2 miles, bear right, following Millwood Avenue (Rt. 50) past Shenandoah University. In 0.3 miles, turn right at a stoplight on Pleasant Valley Road, and in another 0.3 miles, turn right at a stoplight on Lowry Dr. Turn left in 0.1 miles, and in 0.2 miles bear right as the road veers left. The Rotary Shelter will be on the right in 0.2 miles, at the top of a hill.

Directions from the north: Take I-81 south to exit 315 (Rt. 7) and follow Route 7 (Berryville Ave.) west towards Winchester. In 0.9 miles, turn left at a stoplight on Pleasant Valley Rd. 0.3 miles later, turn left at a stoplight on Cork Street. Turn right in 0.4 miles on Bridgeforth Drive, and the Rotary Shelter will be on your left in 0.6 miles.
